**LION MAKER – I WILL FIGHT!**

– II Samuel 23:20-23 – *“A VALIANT MAN ... A DOER OF GREAT DEEDS.”*

1. \_\_\_\_\_ → Fighters don’t walk away when the going gets tough; they fight to the finish for their convictions. Fighters don’t give up when everyone is against them; they fight against the status quo. And fighters don’t shrink back when the odds are against them; they fight back for what they believe. The Enemy comes to steal your joy, kill your dreams, and destroy your life. Jesus came that you might have life! Will YOU fight?
2. \_\_\_\_\_ → Valor is a gift. Those having it never know for sure whether they have it till the test comes. Valor is running toward trouble when everyone else is running away. Until the pain of staying the same becomes greater than the pain of change, nothing happens!
3. \_\_\_\_\_ → Delayed obedience disguised as prudence is disobedience. Faith isn’t logical or illogical; it’s theological. Faith isn’t prudent or imprudent; it’s valiant. *“What if the life you really want, and the future God wants for you, is hiding right now in your biggest problem, your worst failure, your greatest fear?”* – from *In a Pit with a Lion on a Snowy Day*.

**LION MAKER – I WILL RUN TO THE ROAR!**

– II Samuel 23:20 – *“... he climbed down into a pit and killed a lion.”*

1. \_\_\_\_\_ → Don’t accumulate possessions; accumulate experiences. The sad reality is that most people spend their lives accumulating the wrong things. Instead of accumulating experiences, they accumulate possessions. The day you stop dreaming is the day you start dying!
2. \_\_\_\_\_ → Psychologists tell us that we’re born with two fears—the fear of falling and the fear of loud noises. Every other fear is learned, which means that every other fear can be unlearned. Faith is the process of unlearning those fears. “Perfect love casts out fear.” God is in the business of helping us overcome our fears, but HE often does it by bringing us face to face with our worst fears.
3. \_\_\_\_\_ → You can run away from what you’re afraid of, but you’ll be running the rest of your life. At some point you have to face your fear. And when you do, you’ll discover that fear itself is a coward in the face of courage. At the end of our lives, our greatest regrets won’t be the mistakes we made. It’ll be the opportunities we left on the table. What lion do you need to chase?

**Bible Verses – The Message**

<p><b>Luke 2:52 - 52</b> And Jesus matured, growing up in both body and spirit, blessed by both God and people.</p> <p><b>Matthew 28:18-20 - 18</b> Jesus, undeterred, went right ahead and gave his charge: "God authorized and commanded me to commission you: <b>19</b> Go out and train everyone you meet, far and near, in this way of life, marking them by baptism in the threefold name: Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. <b>20</b> Then instruct them in the practice of all I have commanded you. I'll be with you as you do this, day after day after day, right up to the end of the age."</p> <p><b>II Samuel 23:8-17 - 8</b> This is the listing of David's top men. Josheb-Basshebeth, the Tahkemonite. He was chief of the Three. He once put his spear to work against eight hundred - killed them all in a day.<b>9</b> Eleazar son of Dodai the Ahohite was the next of the elite Three. He was with David when the Philistines poked fun at them at Pas Dammim. When the Philistines drew up for battle, Israel retreated.<b>10</b> But Eleazar stood his ground and killed Philistines right and left until he was exhausted - but he never let go of his sword! A big win for God that day. The army then rejoined Eleazar, but all there was left to do was the clean- up. <b>11</b> Shammah son of Agee the Hararite was the third of the Three. The Philistines had mustered for battle at Lehi, where there was a field full of lentils. Israel fled before the Philistines <b>12</b> , but Shammah took his stand at the center of the field, successfully defended it, and routed the Philistines. Another great victory for God! <b>13</b> One day during harvest, the Three parted from the Thirty and joined David at the Cave of Adullam. A squad of Philistines had set up camp in the Valley of Rephaim.<b>14</b> While</p>	<p>David was holed up in the Cave, the Philistines had their base camp in Bethlehem <b>15</b> David had a sudden craving and said, "Would I ever like a drink of water from the well at the gate of Bethlehem!"<b>16</b> So the Three penetrated the Philistine lines, drew water from the well at the gate of Bethlehem, and brought it back to David. But David wouldn't drink it; he poured it out as an offering to God, <b>17</b> saying, "There is no way, God, that I'll drink this! This isn't mere water, it's their life-blood - they risked their very lives to bring it!" So David refused to drink it. This is the sort of thing that the Three did.</p> <p><b>II Samuel 23:18-23 - 18</b> Abishai brother of Joab and son of Zeruiah was the head of the Thirty. He once got credit for killing three hundred with his spear, but he was never named in the same breath as the Three.<b>19</b> He was the most respected of the Thirty and was their captain, but never got included among the Three <b>20</b> Benaiah son of Jehoiada from Kabzeel was a vigorous man who accomplished a great deal. He once killed two lion cubs in Moab. Another time, on a snowy day, he climbed down into a pit and killed a lion.<b>21</b> Another time he killed a formidable Egyptian. The Egyptian was armed with a spear and Benaiah went against him with nothing but a walking stick; he seized the spear from his grip and killed him with his own spear <b>22</b> These are the things that Benaiah son of Jehoiada is famous for. But neither did he ever get ranked with the Three.<b>23</b> He was held in greatest respect among the Thirty, but he never got included with the Three. David put him in charge of his bodyguard.</p>
