THE LARGER STORY – The Value of Human Life! – Genesis 2:26-28 & John 10:10.

1.	——————————————————→ Creation unfolds like a great work of art, a masterpiece in the making. And just as you
	can learn about an author by the stories he tells, you can learn a great deal about an artist from the works he creates. God creates us in his image,
	with powers like unto his own—the ability to reason, to create, to share intimacy, to know joy. He gives us laughter and wonder and imagination.
2.	→ God enables us to love. He gives us the greatest treasure in all creation: a heart. For he
	intends that we should be his intimate allies, who join in the Sacred Circle of intimacy that is the core of the universe, to share in this great Romance.
	We have forgotten what a treasure the human heart is. All of the happiness we have ever known and all of the happiness we hope to find is
	unreachable without a heart. You could not live or love or laugh or cry had God not given you a heart. And with that heart comes the freedom to
	reject him—a will of our own.

TRUE INDENTITY RESTORED - Proverbs 4:23 & Colossians 1:13, 14.

- 1. → Evil was lurking in the Garden. You must understand: the Evil One hates God, hates anything that reminds him of the glory of God ... wherever it exists. Unable to overthrow the Mighty One, he turned his sights on those who bore his image.

GOD'S INTENTION - Isaiah 54:4-8; Jeremiah 31:31-34.

- 1. Created as Image-bearers, we are designed for a heroic intimacy with God, endowed with dignity, a freedom, and a glory that made a passionate loving relationship with him possible.
- 2. _____ → God is a passionate lover who seeks our hearts. As devasting as the Fall was to humanity, God pursued us, inviting us to choose him and the life he offers. He pursues us still! Jesus describes our relationship with him from clay and potter through sheep and shepherd to bride and bridegroom.

SCRIPTURE

<u>Genesis 1:26-28 - 26</u> Then God said, "Let us make mankind in our image, in our likeness, so that they may rule over the fish in the sea and the birds in the sky, over the livestock and all the wild animals, and over all the creatures that move along the ground."<u>27</u> So God created mankind in his own image, in the image of God he created them; male and female he created them.<u>28</u> God blessed them and said to them, "Be fruitful and increase in number; fill the earth and subdue it. Rule over the fish in the sea and the birds in the sky and over every living creature that moves on the ground."

<u>John 10:10 -</u> 10 The thief comes only to steal and kill and destroy; I have come that they may have life, and have it to the full.

<u>Proverbs 4:23 -</u> 23 Above all else, guard your heart, for everything you do flows from it.

<u>Colossians 1:13, 14 - 13</u> For he has rescued us from the dominion of darkness and brought us into the kingdom of the Son he loves, <u>14</u> in whom we have redemption, the forgiveness of sins.

<u>Isaiah 54:4-8 - 4</u> "Do not be afraid; you will not be put to shame. Do not fear disgrace; you will not be humiliated. You will forget the shame of your youth and remember no more the reproach of your widowhood. <u>5</u> For your Maker is your husband—the LORD Almighty is his name—the Holy One of

Israel is your Redeemer; he is called the God of all the earth. 6 The LORD will call you back as if you were a wife deserted and distressed in spirit— a wife who married young, only to be rejected," says your God. 7 "For a brief moment I abandoned you, but with deep compassion I will bring you back. 8 In a surge of anger I hid my face from you for a moment, but with everlasting kindness I will have compassion on you," says the LORD your Redeemer.

Jeremiah 31:31-34 - 31 "The days are coming," declares the LORD, "when I will make a new covenant with the people of Israel and with the people of Judah. 32 It will not be like the covenant I made with their ancestors when I took them by the hand to lead them out of Egypt, because they broke my covenant, though I was a husband to them, "declares the LORD. 33 "This is the covenant I will make with the people of Israel after that time," declares the LORD. "I will put my law in their minds and write it on their hearts. I will be their God, and they will be my people. 34 No longer will they teach their neighbor, or say to one another, 'Know the LORD,' because they will all know me, from the least of them to the greatest," declares the LORD. "For I will forgive their wickedness and will remember their sins no more."
