## WISDOM FOR THE JOURNEY: Psychological & Emotional Consequences

We need help to make decisions about work; all relationships – in speech and conduct; who to trust or avoid; along with being measured by the plumbline of true character. Wisdom from Proverbs offers insight into the concrete experiences of human life that help us take charge of our lives. Proverbs is about *how to* live out your faith in God. There is no true wisdom apart from Jesus. Fools are those who rely on their own knowledge to navigate life. In this study, we will look and listen to hear God's voice and see his Son shining through the book of Proverbs. We will be equipped in every way for our journey!

## THE SECURITY OF GOD'S ORDER (vs INSECURITY)

— Levitus 26: 15-36 → ",,, and if you reject my decrees and abhor my laws and fail to carry out all my commands and so violate my covenants (my way, my truth, my life) then I will do this to you: I will bring on you sudden terror (behalah), wasting diseases and fever (haš·ša·ḥe·pēt) that will destroy your sight and sap your strength...You will plant seed in vain, because your enemies will eat it....and you will flee even when no one is pursuing you... 'As for those of you who are left, I will will also bring despair (morek) into their hearts in the lands of their enemies they will run as though fleeing from the sword, even though no one is pursuing them."

Hasahepet - The indication is the diseased effect of the seed sown because what follows indicates bad seeds as in mildew or fungus causing wheat blast disease: "ye shall sow in vain"; but no doubt diseases of the body are intended!

### THE SECURITY OF GOD'S ORDER - God is ORDER

after worthless things which do not profit and do not deliver, for they are worthless. Worthless – Let's consider one of the strangest and most difficult words in the Hebrew Scriptures. You might think you are quite familiar with this word. After all, it is found in one of the Bible's most famous passages. It occurs in Genesis 1:2 − "and the earth was without form and void." In Hebrew, this is tohu wabohu. Tohu occurs only 39 more times in Scripture. To this day, scholars are unable to clearly identify its etymology or exactly specify its meaning. But this much is clear. Tohu is antithetical to any living thing, healing in each of the areas that sin affects us. Tohu generally describes five related conditions. These are: trackless wasteland, desolation, lifelessness, futility and worthlessness. The common thread behind tohu seems to be a sphere that is alien to all life. It is an ominous, chaotic, desolate, dark, destructive opposition to created order. Consequently, it is filled with peril, menace and foreboding. It is the negation of God and His creation. If there were ever a word that described a place where life is sucked out of you, then tohu is that word. The opposite of tohu is not peace, prosperity, happiness or health. The opposite of tohu is God, for God is order, fulfillment, satisfaction, well-being and life itself.
